

'Matchplay' Rules

The Matchplay competition takes place from May to September. It is played as a Knock-Out competition.

- The draw will be performed at the 'Invitational' and players will be informed about their matches thereafter
- The player drawn first will have the choice of venue (preliminary and first round)
- The player who qualifies first into the next round will have the choice of venue
- It is the players responsibility to organise their matches
- Players to include the Captain in their correspondence about organising the matches and provide the match result to him/her asap after the match (captain@baselbaggers.com)
- Handicaps to be used are the ones from Golfsoftware on the day of play, to be adjusted according to the local course index (day handicap)
- Play from yellow/red tee (men + ladies) when possible, (other tees are allowed but must be agreed on by both players prior to round)
- 90% handicap difference to be used between players
Example 1: Player 1= 18 shots; Player 2= 9 shots; $9 \times 0.9=8.1$, i.e. 8 shots difference
Example 2: Player 1=17 shots; Player 2=12 shots; $5 \times 0.9=4.5$, i.e. 5 shots difference
- In the event of a tie, players must play additional holes
- In the event where no date can be found to play a match in the allotted time (4 weeks maximum or latest 1 week before the next round is due to start, whichever is earliest) the person who has made the most effort to organise the match will be given a bye into the next round.
- In the event of any disputes of rules, please inform the Captain at the earliest opportunity
- Captain will take final decision on any disputes
